The Gator delivers pin-point accuracy for shorter drives and approach shots, even in windy conditions. Available in the widest range of weights and models. DX discs start more stable than rated, and get less stable with use.</p> <p><b>Pro Line Plastic</b> Pro Line is more durable than our DX, yet still offers great grip. Pro drivers have more high speed turn, less low speed fade and more glide than Champion or DX.</p> <p><b>Champion Plastic</b> Champion is our most durable plastic. They come out of the box ready to fly and will retain their original flight characteristics for a long time.</p> <p>What plastic to choose? Once you have thrown a disc listed on the Flight Chart, you can use that as a frame of reference to choose any of our other discs.</p> <p>Our discs are listed from more overstable toward the left side of the chart to more understable toward the right side. The fastest models are listed from top to bottom. Stable to overstable discs tend to fade left at low speeds, but can handle windy situations better. SPEED	<b>Speed</b> — Speed is the ability of the disc to cut through the air. Speed ratings are listed up the left side of the page. Discs with higher numbers are faster. Faster discs go farther into the wind with less effort. Slower discs take more power to throw far, but have less chance to fly past the target.	4	4			<b>Glide</b> — Glide describes the property of the disc being able to maintain loft during flight. More glide is best for new players and for producing maximum distance, especially downwind. A disc rated 6 has the most glide. Beginners should choose discs with more glide.	4	4			GLIDE	
	<b>Turn</b> — High Speed Turn — This is the tendency of a disc to turn over or bank to the right (for RHBH throwers) during the initial part of the flight. A disc with a 0 rating is most resistant to turning over, while a -5 rating will turn the most. Discs rated -2 to -5 make good roller discs.	-2	2			<b>Fade</b> — Low Speed Fade — At the end of the flight, all discs tail off (hook) to the left (for RHBH throwers) but some will hook harder than others.
